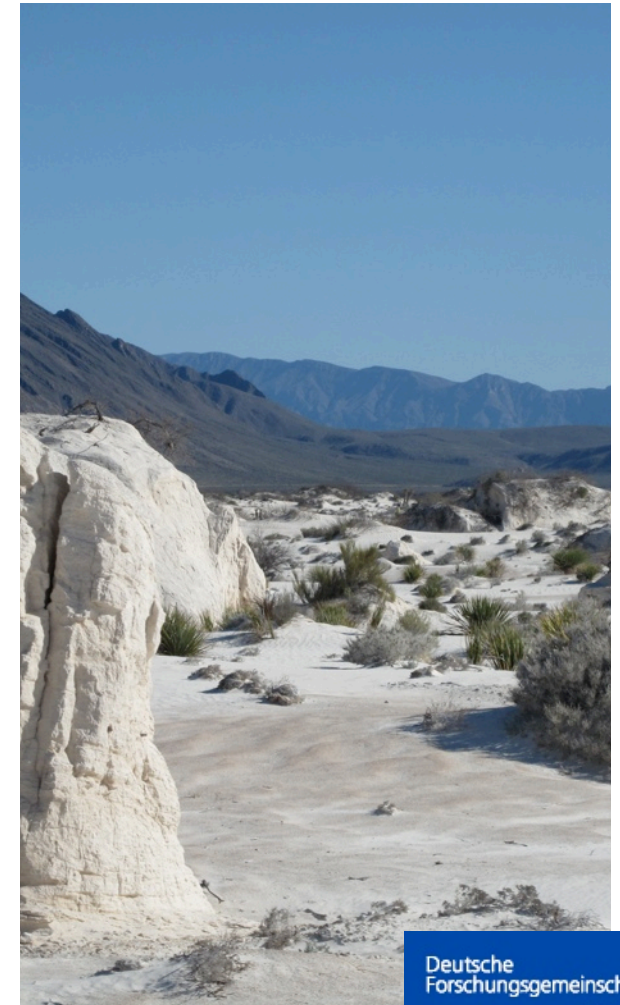

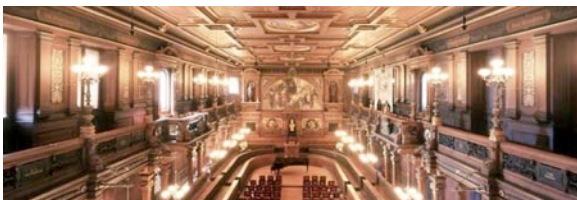
Venue / Travel / Accommodation
